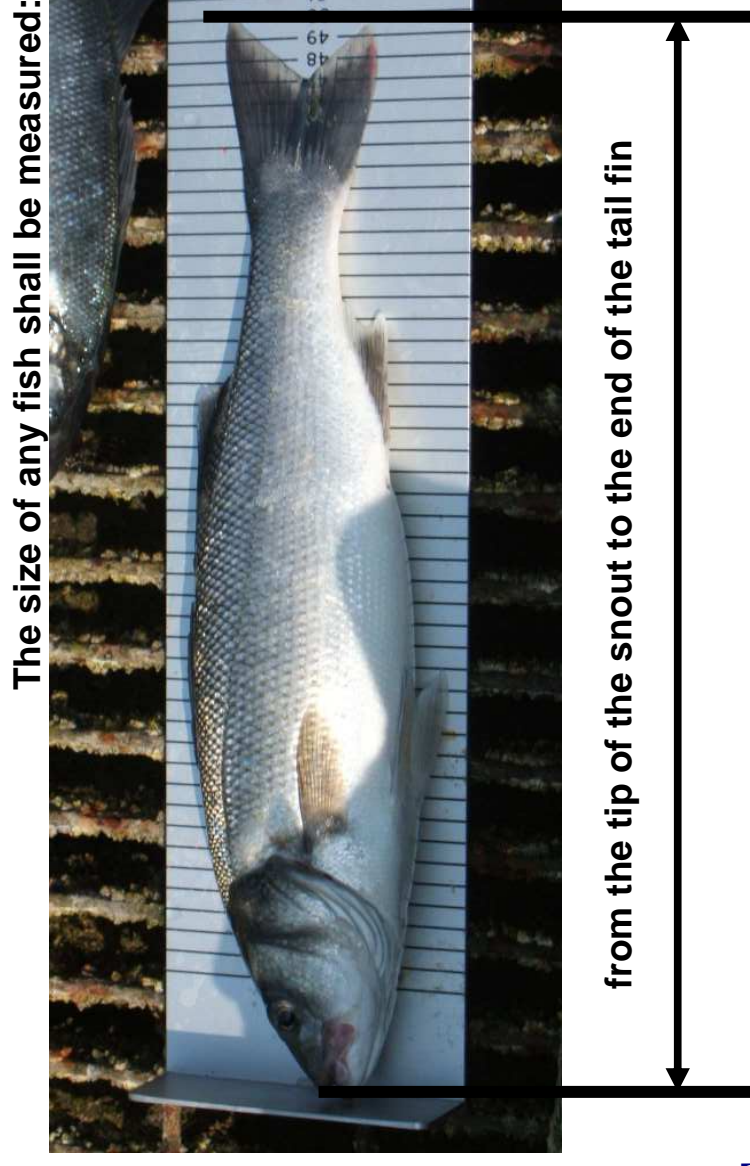
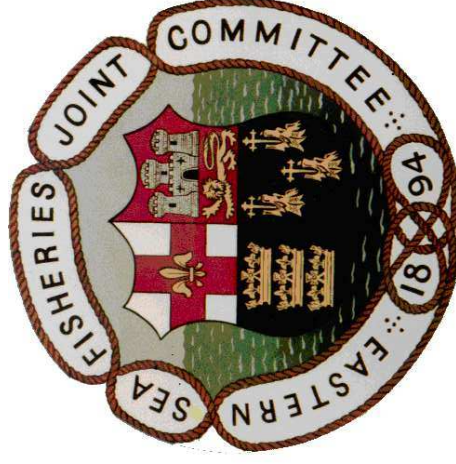


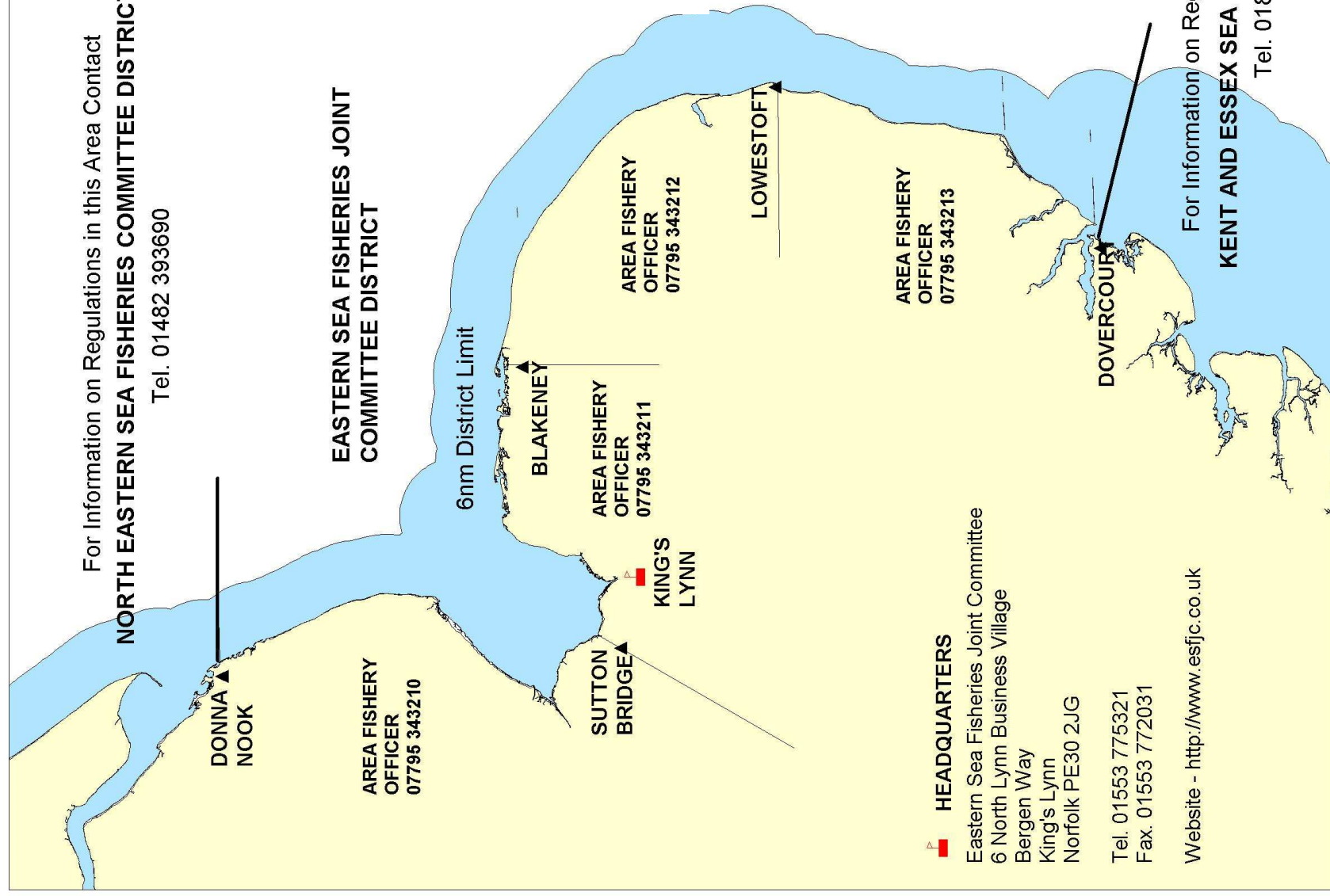
Recreational Sea Angling: what you must know before you go.



The size of any fish shall be measured:

from the tip of the snout to the end of the tail fin

TAKE TACKLE & LITTER HOME. PLEASE RESPECT THE ENVIRONMENT YOU HAVE COME TO ENJOY.



Minimum Sizes

Species must be landed whole.

Please return with care fish you do not wish to take for personal consumption.

Bass	36cm	Horse Mackerel	15cm
Mackerel	30cm	Sole	24cm
Whiting	27cm	Herring	20cm
Pollack	30cm	Sardine	11cm
Cod	35cm	Saithe	35cm
Plaice	27cm	Hake	27cm
Haddock	30cm	Ling	63cm
Megrim	20cm	Blue Ling	70cm

Tope: No person shall remove from within the ESFJC district any Tope or part(s) of a Tope. Any Tope, if caught must be returned to the sea immediately.

Salmon & Sea Trout are regulated by the Environment Agency.
